

#### Sunday, 9 August 1:00 PM Critical Thinking: TED Talks about the Reliability of Memory

Memory is not as reliable, powerful, or as objective as we like to believe. We will watch and discuss two TED Talks by psychologists Elizabeth Loftus and Daniel Kanneman which discuss faulty eyewitness testimony and the role of stories in constructing our memories.

Psychologist Elizabeth Loftus studies memories. More precisely, she studies false memories, when people either remember things that didn't happen or



remember them differently from the way they really were. It's more common than you might think, and Loftus shares some startling stories and statistics — and raises some important ethical questions.

Using examples from vacations to colonoscopies, Nobel laureate and founder of behavioral economics Daniel Kahneman reveals how our "experiencing selves" and our "remembering selves" perceive happiness differently. This new insight has profound implications for economics, public policy — and our own self-awareness.
